

PELICAN YACHT CLUB HOUSE RULES

The following house rules have been formulated to assure the proper and orderly use of and enjoyment of the club's facilities by members and their guests and to prevent any abuses. It is the DUTY of every member to help enforce these rules.

- ◆PYC will not be responsible for loss of or damage to property belonging to members or their guests.
- ◆PYC assumes no liability for injuries to members or to guests, regardless of the nature of the injury or its cause.
- ◆All members are liable for property damaged or removed by them from the house and grounds and are responsible for all acts committed by their guests.
- ◆Offenses should be reported to the Commodore who will contact the responsible member and submit cost of damages to the Treasurer for billing.
- ◆Children under 13 years of age shall not swim off the pier unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
- ◆There shall be no swimming at any time at the launching ramp.
- ◆Children six years and under shall wear life jackets while on the piers.
- ◆No beer cans, bottles, or other refuse is to be thrown into the water or laid on the grounds, piers, or in the clubhouse. All cans and refuse are to be placed in the trashcans.
- ◆All food, beverages, containers, food carriers, clothing, or other personal belongings shall be removed from the premises upon departure.
- ◆Sails kept in the South Room must be stored on the cross-supports from the ceiling or if in bags must be hung from the hooks on the outside wall of the room.
- ◆The large Sail-Box is reserved for the club's Flying Scot sails.
- ◆Members must be present with invited guests.
- ◆Powerboat operators are requested to give docking priority to sailboats on leeward side of docks.
- ◆Motor boats approaching or leaving dock or ramp areas must hold down their speed sufficiently to avoid disturbing or damaging moored boats.
- ◆Water Skiing or speeding near dock or ramp areas is prohibited.
- ◆Anyone docking next to a moored boat has a responsibility to protect the moored boat and their own boat from damage.
- ◆No parking on driveways, ramp, or approach to ramp. Vehicle and trailer must be moved from ramp immediately after launching or picking up boat.
- ◆**TO AVOID CONGESTION, MEMBERS ARE RECOMMENDED TO LEAVE IGNITION KEYS IN THEIR PARKED VEHICLES SO THEY CAN BE MOVED IF NECESSARY**
- ◆No BB guns, pellet rifles or firearms of any kind are to be brought onto the PYC premises.
- ◆Although spending the night in the clubhouse is not prohibited, other members' rights cannot be infringed upon. Therefore, the house should be in order and personal effects removed by 9:00 A.M.
- ◆Primary sleeping area should be the South Room.
- ◆Sleepers do not have priority over general facility.

DEPARTURE LIST

THE LAST CLUB MEMBER TO LEAVE THE PREMISES ON ANY DAY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

1. TURNING OFF THE HEATER/AIR CONDITIONER AND/OR FANS.
2. EMPTY ALL TRASHCANS –(Kitchen, Restrooms & Porch.)
3. CHECK THAT ALL ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE REFRIGERATOR) ARE OFF. (Television, VCR, Radio, Stove Top, Oven, Microwave, Coffeemaker and any other appliance that may be in the clubhouse.)
4. TURNING OFF THE WATER MAIN (behind the house) IN FREEZING WEATHER.
5. CARRYING GARBAGE CAN(s) UP TO THE STREET.
6. LOCKING ALL DOORS. (Sliding Glass Doors, Back Door, Storage Room Door and the Main Entrance Door.)
7. TURNING ALL THE LIGHTS OFF (Kitchen, Restrooms, Main Room, Hall, and Porch)
8. LOCK THE ENTRANCE GATE.
